

Prep 2010, Enrolments – Proof of Birth Date Required:

Is my child eligible to enrol in Prep in 2010?

In order to be enrolled in Prep in 2010, a child must turn 5 years of age between 1 July 2009 and 30 June 2010 (inclusive) i.e. a child born 1 July 2004 to 30 June 2005 (inclusive). **Please note that a Birth Certificate (original) or original Extract of Birth Certificate, or a certified copy (e.g. by a Justice of the Peace) will be required.** An Application for Enrolment will only be confirmed subject to proof of Birth Date being sighted.

The Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages is encouraging parents to apply for birth certificates now to avoid the new school year rush. To apply for a standard or commemorative birth certificate you can:

- download an application form from www.justice.qld.gov.au/bdm
- visit the registry at 110 George Street, Brisbane or your nearest courthouse.

Don't leave it to the last minute – apply for a birth certificate now.
